

**Jekyll & HYDE Parent permission form and information. Read Entirely!**

**Time Commitment**

We have provided a schedule for you and your parent/guardian to look through. This is to give you a general idea of the time commitment necessary to participate. You will be expected to be at every rehearsal for which your character appears on the schedule.

Please look over the schedule and indicate any potential conflicts you may have. Conflicts include: **vacations, doctors appointments, weddings, etc...** You should then return this calendar with the conflicts to Mr. Wayne on the audition day (Dec. 4<sup>th</sup>).

Only conflicts listed on this calendar will be considered excused absences. Of course, circumstances arise and we will deal with them on an individual basis. **But if conflicts “arise” too frequently, it will be grounds for dismissal from the show.**

**Unexcused absences cannot and will not be tolerated. More than one unexcused absence will also be grounds for dismissal under the discretion of Mr. Wayne.**

Be as specific as possible on the Jekyll & HYDE Conflicts sheet.

***NOTE: Performance dates are non-negotiable! You must be available for ALL of them.***

**Fees**

Below is a chart of required and optional expenses.

<b>Participation Fee (Required)</b> <i>(It is extremely expensive to put on a musical. It costs hundreds of dollars per student. This fee will be a great help towards offsetting our cost so we can continue to offer this great experience to the students.</i>	\$65
<b>Make-Up (Required)</b> <i>(A must have for sanitary reasons! Each actor will need their own eyeliner and mascara.</i>	
<b>Dance Shoes (Required - Role dependant)</b> <i>Students will be required to supply their own shoes as directed by the design team. Students will get to keep these shoes.</i> <b>Undergarments (Required)</b> <i>Each actor will need to provide their own undergarments including a Cami or undergarment.</i>	
<b>Tech Week Dining Program (optional)</b> <i>(Last week of rehearsal only. Approximately 4 days)</i>	\$20
<b>T-Shirt (optional)</b> <i>(Great souvenir! Great way to show pride and it's walking publicity for the show!)</i>	\$15

The dance audition requires very little preparation. Show up on time and make sure you are wearing clothes that permit movement. JEANS DON'T WORK! Be sure to bring socks too! Sometimes turning in gym shoes can be challenging.
